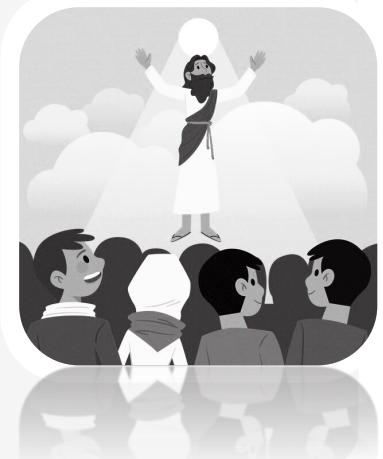
**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION**

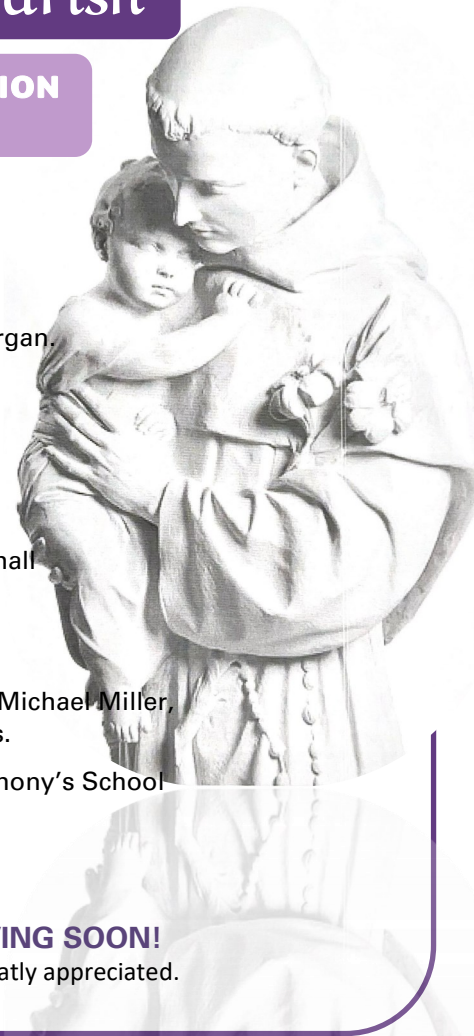

## INTERNATIONAL PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE OF FATIMA

St Anthony's will be hosting the statue of Our Lady of Fatima

**SATURDAY, APRIL 13, 2024**  
**Starting with Mass at 9:00am - 6:30pm**  
**All day private prayers and veneration**  
**Vigil Mass at 4:30pm followed by Rosary**

The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima has been traveling since 1947, bringing the message of Fatima to a world in need.

The purpose of the Pilgrim Virgin Statue tours is to bring the graces of Fatima and Our Lady's message of hope, peace and salvation to those many millions of people who may never have an opportunity to make a pilgrimage to Fatima itself.

The statue was created by the famous sculptor Jose Thedim. Sister Lucia herself instructed him and later remarked that she had never seen any image which resembled the actual apparition of Our Lady.

The statue has visited more than 100 countries, including Russia and China, bringing the great message of salvation and hope, "the peace plan from Heaven," to countless millions of people. The statue last visited Canada (Toronto) in 2019 and is in Vancouver 5-16 April.

- 4:30 Vigil Mass followed by the Rosary
- Opportunity for individual prayer until 6:30pm.
