You may wonder why the Church gives so much attention to our human experience of community. In a nation built on rugged individualism, why is our worship experience focused so much on our Shared Prayers at Mass, the Kiss of Peace, processing together to receive Holy Communion, Communal Penance Services, and so forth?

Well, the answer has a great deal to do with the very nature of God in whose image and likeness we are made. Today we rejoice in the revelation of the **Holy Trinity**.

It is upon this reality that Christianity is built.

God is in Himself a community. In this community we are made in God's image and likeness, and that in Christ we are to become like God.

God is Three Persons, a community of Persons that exists in love. That is the inner nature of God, that is the life of heaven, and that is what we are called to live here on earth.

Jesus revealed to His disciples the great mystery of our faith - the Trinitarian God and the inseparable union of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Jesus' mission is to reveal the glory of God to us - a Trinity of persons: God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit - and to unite us with God in a community of love. The ultimate end, the purpose for which God created us, is the entry of God's creatures into the perfect unity of the Blessed Trinity.

In Baptism we are called to share in the life of the Holy Trinity here on earth in faith and after death in eternal light. The Trinity is not only a celebration of divine relationships; it is also the assurance of God's continuous presence in the world at all times.
