Traditionally, Pentecost is celebrated as the beginnings of the Church. The apostles receive the promised Spirit of Jesus and they are transformed, go out to all nations, spread the Word and the Church is born. Just as Jesus was anointed with the Spirit at the beginning of His ministry so also the apostles needed the anointing of the Spirit to be effective in their mission.

The Holy Spirit is given to all who are baptized into Christ to enable them to live a new way of life - a life of love, peace, joy and righteousness. The Holy Spirit fills our hearts with the love of God and He gives us the strength and courage we need in order to live as grace-filled disciples of Jesus. The Spirit helps us in our weakness and guides us in our pilgrimage.

After His resurrection Jesus "breathed" on His disciples and gave them the Holy Spirit. Just as God breathed life into Adam, so the gift of the Holy Spirit is an imparting of "new life" to His people. With the gift of the Holy Spirit a new creation begins. God recreates us for His glory. Jesus' gift of peace to His disciples was more than an absence of troubles and problems in life. His peace included the forgiveness of sins and the fullness of life and goodness.

Pentecost is the way we are to be, or live, as Church. The real marvel is that the Holy Spirit works through us and in us in our world. The Spirit was there from the beginning at creation and 'before', and has delighted in His work with humanity ever since, above all in the work of Christ the Lord, and is there working in and through us in our world to bring the peace of God to us.

What do we need to do?
 Pray daily for the Spirit.
 Bishop Sheen did that every day, and joked that if he was still selfish on the day he died, it would be God's fault, not his, because he daily prayed for the spirit of healing.

ST ANTHONY'S NOVENA & FEAST DAY

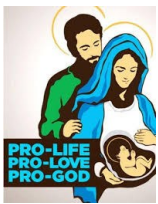
Everyone is invited to the NOVENA leading up to the Feast Day of Saint Anthony.
